

Chalice Kids update. 02/18

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For the past two years, Chalice Kids offered our children two sessions per month, covering more than 20 topics. Both monthly sessions revolved around the same monthly topic. The first session of the month was used for Story telling - using narrative to become familiar with the various sub-themes embedded in the monthly topic. The second session focused on exploration and application of the topic: our younger group would explore the basics of being Unitarian while the older group looked into its wider - as well as personal implications.

2018 brought the exciting development of a monthly Chalice Circle, based in the in the Southern Suburbs. Rather than having two separate children's services we decided to integrate Chalice Kids and the Chalice Circle and cover the same monthly topic. The Chalice Circle venue provides children with space to express themselves freely, hence our decision to move the Story telling session to the Chalice Circle. Children can now not only listen to a story but also enact it, sing, and dance and do art - a much more fun way to learn!

These changes partially resolve the space issue at the church building but also create a structure within which Chalice Kids can be expanded to other parts of Cape Town.

In summary, children between the ages of 6 and 13 will be able to attend:

- An Exploration of a relevant monthly topic on the 2nd Sunday of every month, presented to different age groups. This will be held at the usual time during the church service
- A Story /activity on the same topic during the Chalice Circle, held every 4th/last Saturday of the month.
